RECENT CASE HIGHLIGHTS

The following is a representative sample of the work undertaken by members of the Employment team.

- Applied for a High Court injunction against two former senior employees who had misappropriated our client's commercial data/software and attempted to set up a competing business. Our quick and decisive action removed the threat to the business and enabled a claim for substantial damages.
- Worked closely with a well-known international company during the major restructuring of its operations. This included bringing external staff in-house (via TUPE) and the reorganisation of its entire sales function.
- Advising a green-tech energy company on the hive down and restructuring of its business and the flotation of its subsidiary on AIM
- Successfully defended a company in a class action brought by 40 employees claiming excessive holiday pay.
